On September 30, 2025, the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the settlement agreement between the Providence Foundation and the City of San Francisco and its Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing. This agreement now brings closure to the 2024 allegations of fraud and marks an important milestone in the Foundation's continued mission to serve the City's most vulnerable. Beyond the settlement, the Providence Foundation has invested more than \$300,000.00 in the past year to enhance transparency and strengthen operational practices as well as lay the groundwork for future growth and improved service delivery to the City's unhoused and unfed residents.

Leadership from the Providence Foundation, the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing, and the Mayor's Office will come together to discuss the resolution and share more about the Foundation's innovative programs and ongoing commitment to the San Francisco community.
